

Equity: Emerging markets – progressing on ESG

In our largest asset class, we look for responsible and sustainable investments with managers who create positive social and environmental impact alongside returns that outperform benchmarks.

As global equity investors, we recognise the importance of sustainable development and ESG challenges across emerging markets. We also believe they offer exciting opportunities for investors who care about sustainable progress.

Within the Anthos multimanager fund of funds equity portfolio, one emerging markets equity strategy targets high returns and long term capital growth by investing in a portfolio of primarily equity and equity-related securities traded in emerging markets.

The manager hired a Head of ESG, in 2020, and in 2021 brought in two more team members. We are encouraged by their engagement with their portfolio companies on topics from human rights in supply chains, to carbon reporting and corporate governance issues such as executive remuneration. We will continue to monitor this strategy's efforts to improve their ESG practice as well as achieving financial performance.
